The NDS members should submit competitive as well as non-competitive bids in electronic format using Primary Market Operation (PMO) module of NDS. All bids should be submitted by12.30 P.M.
- 3. The price percent expected by the bidder should be expressed up to two decimal points. An investor can submit more than one bid at different prices, but a separate application should be submitted for each bid. The aggregate amount of bids submitted by a person in an auction should not exceed the notified amount of that auction.
- 4. The result of the auctions will be displayed at RBI, Mumbai Office, Fort, Mumbai on Friday, November 3, 2006. Successful bidders should deposit with that Office the price amount of Government Stock(s) covered by their successful bids on November 6, 2006 by 3.00 P.M. in cash or by cheque on their account with RBI, Mumbai or by Banker's Pay Order.

Both the Stocks will be eligible for "When Issued" trading for a period commencing from October 30, 2006 to November 3, 2006 in accordance with the guidelines on 'When Issued' transactions in Central Government Securities' issued by the Reserve Bank of India vide circular No. RBI /2005-06/382 dated May 3, 2006.
- 6. Interest on the Government Stocks will be paid half-yearly. The Stocks will be governed by the provisions of Public Debt Act, 1944 and the rules framed there under.
- 7. The Stocks will be eligible for ready forward facility.
