<u>Liquidity Adjustment Facility – Repo and Reverse Repo Rates</u>

As announced today in the <u>Second Quarter Review of the Monetary Policy 2013-14</u>, it has been decided to increase the Repo rate under the Liquidity Adjustment Facility (LAF) by 25 basis points from 7.50 per cent to **7.75 per cent** with immediate effect.

- 2. Consequent to the change in the Repo rate, the Reverse Repo rate under the LAF will stand automatically adjusted to **6.75 per cent** with immediate effect.
- 3. All other terms and conditions of the current LAF scheme will remain unchanged.
